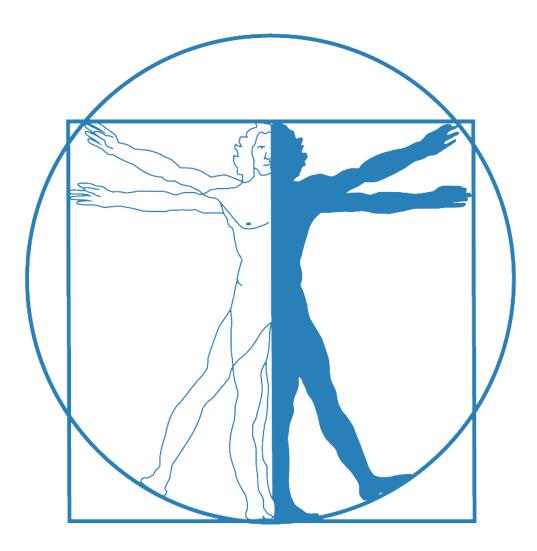

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Introduction

The aim of this financial report is to provide a clear overview and evaluation of the finances of the spring 2018 semester. It outlines the financial aspects of the board activities and committees as well as the expenses of the past semester. Clarity about UCMSA Universalis' expenses is necessary to support the Independent Body in its tasks of reviewing Universalis' financial books. Furthermore, it is necessary to provide all members of UCMSA Universalis with insight of the association's financial status when inquired. Finally, the financial report is to be used by future treasurers of the association, as to learn from mistakes made in the past. It is to be used as reference to improve financial matters within the association and to maintain a clear overview and understanding of the financial processes of UCMSA Universalis.

Semester Report

Budget Allocation

Budget allocation for this semester was similar to that of spring semester 2017. Main differences were due to a number of new committees. For instance, Excursion Committee (EXCO; spent around €500) and Film Committee (spent around €100) were new additions to the semester plan this academic year. Specifically this spring semester, Well-Being Committee and Circus were approved, although both hardly used Universalis budget. Additionally, PINE recently got accepted as Universalis committee, which will have repercussions in the coming semester budget plans. A few committees that did exist in last year's semester plan have become more active and have started spending more: Feminism Society (FemSoc), Music Committee, Musical Committee, Film Committee and Spiritual Enlightenment. Each committee's semester plan was revised during the board weekend and the respective budgets passed during the GA, in accordance with some changes deemed necessary by the board members.

A lot of committees did not use their full allocated budget. This resulted in leftover budget close to the end of the semester. Usually this would have been publicized and discussed during the last (election) GA to reallocate some of this budget, however, due to miscommunication within the board, this was not done this semester. Nonetheless, some extra budget was allocated upon request, most notably to Music Committee for necessary new equipment and to Spiritual Enlightenment for extra costs with some events. Also, some amount of the emergency budget was spent on champagne for the capstone hand-in and on gin & tonic for an end-of-year event with the staff in the courtyard, costs that were previously covered by staff without interference of Universalis. A final important point is that some committees drastically went over budget because of unexpected factors. One such case of overspending was the summer gala, which resulted in a major loss because of a combination of late advertising and bad communication. This highlights the importance of early advertising for large events, as well as potential help from the social board if necessary. Another event that required extra money was the graduation party, where $\notin 200$ had to be paid extra due to damages to the venue (Tragos). Last but not least, more than $\notin 800$ had to be spent on t-shirts for the tournament because of the lack of sponsors and a misunderstanding with the company.

Bank

No bank transitioning needed to be done going into this semester. However, because of new legislation within ABN Amro the new treasurer for Fall 2018 has to be officially registered as card holder. The new treasurer together with the old treasurer also arranged for the smooth transitioning of the KvK account and responsibilities, which are now given to the President, Secretary and Treasurer (in line with our statutes and the policy manual), meaning that these three are the only holders of legal responsibility in the eyes of Dutch law.

Budget GA

During the budget GA in February, the current president and the current treasurer jointly chaired the General Assembly, and the treasurers of the committees presented their budget separately. This went over

well, since questions were asked directly towards the committee treasurers and whenever a question concerned matters of the Social Board, the current treasurer or president answered them to the best of their abilities. A point that came up repeatedly was the difference in bonding money between the Social Board and the Academic Council, which means this will probably be adjusted in the Policy Manual the coming GA.

Beer and Fruit Sales

As every year, we have carried out beer sales at our events (beers for 50 cents). As described in last semester's financial report, this leads to a structural loss of about \notin 5 per crate. It is argued that this loss on our behalf should nonetheless be pursued, because it benefits the community of UCM. Still, this loss should be included in next semester's budget plan, something that is not done currently. Regarding fruit money, we have lowered the number of fruit baskets per week from 4 to 3 because of an excess in fruit. Although with the fruit price of 50 cents the costs are in theory fully covered for, in practice there is a small loss because of people failing to pay. This is an issue that should be looked into more in detail the coming semester.

Digitalisation of the Bookkeeping

Although I did not personally focus on this point during my time in the board, past treasurers have looked into ways to digitalize the bookkeeping process. Although a lot of bookkeeping programs are not compatible with our current bank system (ABN Amro), future treasurers could look into other ways to digitalize the reimbursement and internal payment forms. However, I do believe some kind of physical version of these forms should be kept, as actual receipts are also physical (and in that form less easy to falsify).

Furthermore, it is essential that future treasurers keep using Excel on Google Drive over the Microsoft Excel program for day-to-day bookkeeping (which is required next to the paper versions), because it is easier to share with both the Independent Body as well as with our Social Executive who puts these documents on the Universalis website.

Pin Machine

The past semester, we again used a pin machine from the Dominicanen bookstore. More and more committees have started using the pin as payment option for their events, which I see as a positive development. However, there was a major issue with the pin this semester. There were some internal changes within the staff of Dominicanen (as I found out later), which led to a complete lack of communication for a couple of months from their side. This resulted in money that had been paid with the pin machine not being transferred back to the Universalis account on a monthly basis - as it had been the previous semesters. This in turn led to unclarity regarding the exact amount of money made during large events. In essence, this was both my personal mistake (for not checking for transferred money from Dominicanen sooner) as well as that of Dominicanen. Now, there we have a new contactperson, with which I have had a few meetings together with the new treasurer to ensure a smoother transitioning than last semester. However, it might be an idea to look at other options for a pin machine, independent of Dominicanen.

UCSRN Contribution Fee

As stated in the last semester plan, the annual contribution fee to UCSRN was lowered to €1000. As UCSRN works on a yearly rather than half-yearly basis, I was not personally involved with the budget plan at the beginning of the academic year. As discussed by the last Universalis treasurer, UCSRN adhered a more bottom-up approach by having individual University Colleges organize events independently with only UCSRN funding. However, this proved very chaotic and non-transparent at several events (Spotlight and the tournament), thus I encourage our next to advocate for more top-down interference from the UCSRN boards. Another point regarding UCSRN refers to travel costs reimbursements. Because we are one of the farthest away UCs, we often end up paying higher travel costs than other UCs (e.g. when traveling to UCSRN GAs with a group that is too small for a group ticket). So, I believe that reimbursements for this should be assessed more flexibly and on an individual basis rather than according to the general rule currently in place. On a last note, I personally had quite some trouble communicating with the UCSRN treasurer and receiving reimbursements at all, so I hope this will go more smoothly next semester.

Finances in the Next Semester

In the upcoming semester, some minor issues from this semester will need to be sorted out and documented properly as they took place after the books had been closed. Contact with Cafe Forum will have to be established to ask about the invoice from Beginning of Period Drinks in February, an issue that has been ongoing since then due to bad communication from their side. Next, the final costs of the summer gala need to be sorted out with the venue (the Belgian Onder de Brug), as there was some trouble in communication as well. In addition, the expense report must be altered to show the updated expenditure for books as there are some amounts to be paid during summer week, amongst others, that will be made after the closure of the books. Finally, once the amount from pin transactions has been received by Dominicanen, the actual budget surplus will have to be checked and possibly revised. This will be dealt with by the new treasurer by the next academic year.

Financial Future of Universalis

For the financial future of Universalis, I have envisioned a few things. They include:

- A reconsideration of the UCM-contribution towards Universalis after the Fall 2017 Semester, since we have struggled with spending the money in the Spring Semester, and if the theft had not happened in the Fall Semester, we would have had considerable surplus there as well. However, the new Universalis Social Board shall have to decide on the basis of more recent numbers and less circumstantial numbers whether they want a reduction in the funding of UCM.
- A financially independent AC. What this means is that the AC would need to adopt their own statutes and will have to hold their own GAs. This would then mean that the AC can receive their contribution directly from UCM instead of letting this go through the general Social Board contribution, as well as that the AC can then operate independently with regards to finances, legal responsibility and representation.

- It might be a good idea to follow-up on the approach of other UC's where they do online ticket sales. Especially for expensive tickets, such as for the Gala and the Anti-Racism Workshop, can then be easily sold.
