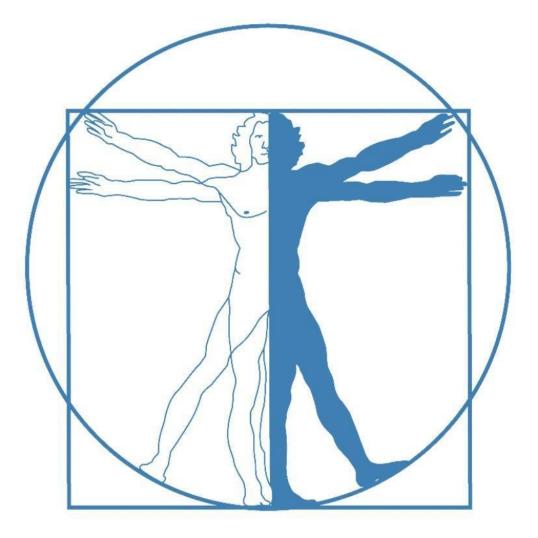
UCMSA Universalis Financial Report

Fall 2023/24

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Introduction

This report provides an overview of the financial activity of UCMSA Universalis in the Fall 2023/24 semester. Specifically, it covers the period between 4th September 2023 and 11th February 2024. The main Fall budget is allocated among 23 committees and the three Universalis boards (Academic Board, Executive Board, Social Board) and was voted upon in the General Assembly on 21st September 2023. As usual, UCMSA received a semesterly contribution of 13,000€ from UCM.

Spring 2022/23 Budget

Some committees sent in reimbursement requests from the Spring 2022/23 budget after the previous financial report had already been finalised. We also received a $300 \in$ deposit back, leading this budget section to be at an overall profit of $59.01 \in$. Not included in the table is a payment of $100 \in$ to the study association Aperture. This was not technically part of the Spring budget, but they gave us a $100 \in$ deposit for lending some of our equipment last semester, and we paid it back this semester after receiving back the equipment.

Spring 2022/23 Surplus

Fall 2023/24 Budget

For the Fall 2023/24 semester, 23 committees and the 3 boards had a total of $23,030.75 \in$ approved in the General Assembly, $5,995.22 \in$ of which were used as of the cutoff for this report. Excluding contingency (a budget puffer for unexpected emergency expenses), a total of $19,972.75 \in$ were budgeted. When contingency had to be used for a budget point, this is indicated by an asterisk is in 'used budget' column. This section presents a shortened overview (beginning with the boards, followed by the committees), for a full overview please refer to the accompanying documents.

Social Board

Last semester, we decided not to budget any money for drinks, as they are technically assumed to be self-funding. However, we ended up having to take money out of contingency because we made a slight loss. This semester we decided to just budget for drinks fully, but this is also not ideal, as it artificially inflates our budgeted expenditures. We spent 732.66€ on drinks and made 669.50€ back, leading to the 63.16€ spent indicated below. In the future, we will budget for drinks in a more realistic way.

Fall 2023/24 Charity Donation

Any profits made by the charity committee do not flow back into the UCMSA budget but are donated at the end of the semester / beginning of the following semester. Within the period of this financial report, we transferred 581€ to the Global Giving Foundation for the Spring 2022/23 semester (missing 38 cents as only whole numbers were accepted, these will be added to the next donation). The Fall 2023/24 donation has not yet been made, but the charity committee collected 588.30€ for it. Of this, 245.66€ were collected in cash (mostly from Waffle Wednesdays), 220.64€ from SumUp payments during Waffle Wednesdays, 9€ from SumUp payments for the Cookie Decorating, and 113€ from transfers for the Valentine's Event. The actual donation will be recorded in the following report.

Any expected layovers from committee budgets have been mentioned throughout the report. Additionally, we already collected 2,040.05€ in student payments for the Fall 2023/24 merch release, the invoice for which will be included in the next report.

Review and Conclusion

Overall, the board is extremely happy with how this semester went and proud of our work within the community and behind the scenes. Having several members with previous Universalis experience on the board helped to keep our processes smooth and thereby also made my job as treasurer easier. Most challenges that I discussed in the previous financial report could all be avoided this semester, as little money had to be taken out of contingency, merchandise prices were adjusted, subscriptions have been cancelled, communication issues with committee members were largely resolved, and no committee members collected any money in their private bank accounts. For this latter point, I attempted to further improve financial proceedings within Universalis, by introducing a new and clearer ticketing system for committees. In previous semesters, it was common practice for committee members to collect ticket money on their private bank accounts. For reasons of transparency and proper bookkeeping, this is not good practice. Thus, we encouraged committees to contact me as the treasurer about any events that require tickets, to then either add them to the UCMSA Eventix account (which was previously only used by the Party Committee), or have participants transfer the money directly to the UCMSA bank account. This seems to have worked well this semester, although it is yet to be seen how this impacts the workload of the treasurer if the number of events with ticketing were to increase.

A challenge that remains from last semester is that a few committee- and also board members handed in their reimbursement requests late despite repeated reminders, meaning that not all expenditures can be covered in the appropriate financial report. We also faced three additional challenges. The first challenge was that we had to introduce financial sanctions on a committee that failed to adhere to discussed agreements and deadlines. This is not a commonly done practice, but together with the Independent Body, we decided that it was necessary to freeze any reimbursements to this committee until these issues were resolved. While this was a somewhat new situation to deal with, we are content with the way it was handled and hope that no need for sanctions will arise again. A second new challenge was that we observed two committees accidentally making profit for UCMSA for their events. This occurred both for the Excursion Committee's Winter Hike and the Party Committee's Winter Gala. It is never our intention to profit off of events and the committee members were immediately contacted about these occurrences and asked to consider them in their future budgeting. The biggest issue we faced this semester was underutilization of budget. Last semester, me made a slight loss of around 90€, while this semester our bank holdings increased by of over 8,000€. Committees budgeted around the same amount as in the previous semester but used a lot less of this money. For example, five committees did not use any of their allocated budget at all, and of this money that was spent, much was used by the same few committees. Thus, the issue does not seem to less intention to spend budget, but a lack of commitment, time, and energy of committee members to organize their planned events. To find potential solutions for this, we held an open floor discussion during our last General Assembly (where we have a lot of committee members present) and amongst other things decided to have the Social Board take a more active role again towards their committees. We made it clear to committees that we want them to use the planned budget and create nice events for the UCM community, and that they can always contact the SB if they need help with anything. The treasurer of the upcoming semester also decided to do less budget cuts during the board weekend, meaning that more budget will be planned. The impacts of this will be evaluated in the next report, which will hopefully show a better utilization of the budget we have available. Overall, I look back on a very positive and fulfilling semester and am overall confident in UCMSA's financial health going into the Spring 2023/24 semester.
